RULES & REGULATIONS

Registration application

Registration will be held exclusively through our online application form, available at:
www.iomma.net

Rules & regulations

- 1) The call for application aims exclusively at artists from the Indian Ocean area (list of eligible countries detailed in the online form). Groups or artists that were selected and took part in the 2018 edition are not allowed to apply for 2019.
- 2) The closing date for application will be on November, 30th 2018.
- 3) Only online registrations are valid. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 4) Once applications are closed, IOMMa's jury and selection committee will review all files and carry out a representative selection of artists.
- 5) In the event of their selection for IOMMa 2019, artists may be asked exclusive rights for the performance in Reunion Island (applies for non-resident bands).
- 6) Selected artist(s) will ensure their availability to attend IOMMa from June 3rd to 6th, 2019.
- 7) IOMMa will take care of the following expenses for selected artists:

Non-residents artists

- Accomodation
- Local tranfers
- Per diem
- Evening meal on the day of the performance
- Passes for the duration of the event

Resident artists

- Evening meal on the day of the performance
- Passes for the duration of the event

NB: Air travel for members of Reunionese groups living abroad will not be supported by IOMMa.



- 8) According to budget possibilities, IOMMa will provide a minimum fee or compensation to selected bands. In the same way, Scènes Australes will take in charge partially or totally air travel for non residents artists.
- 9) For each selected band, IOMMa will provide one professional pass for the whole event to one person accompanying the band.
- 10) Scènes Australes is the association designated to lead the IOMMa project. Its president will be authorized to settle on any situation that is not covered by those regulations.
